### **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### **1.0 Rules**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2005-2008.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply..
- 1.4 The Organising Authority will require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising in accordance with Regulation 20.3(d).(i)

#### **2.0 Changes to Racing Rules**

The Racing Rules will be changed in accordance with rule 86 as follows:

- 2.1 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

#### **3.0 Changes to Class Rules**

#### **4.0 Eligibility and Entry**

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Javelin class that comply with their class rules.
- 4.2 Advance entries will be accepted until the **closing date of 1800hrs on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2007**, by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of \$100.00 and mailing it to Javelin Nationals, PO Box 51, Opua 0241, Bay of Islands.
- 4.3 Sailors travelling from the South Island will receive a 50% discount on their entry fee.
- 4.4 Late entries, accompanied by an additional late entry fee of \$50.00 may be accepted at the Race Committee's discretion until 0930hrs on Friday 6th April 2007.
- 4.5 Measurement requirements are that all New Sails, Boat Weight and Mast will be checked.
- 4.6 New boats maybe required to submit proof of holding a valid measurement certificate at registration.
- 4.7 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.
- 4.8 Sanders Cup Entrant's approved equipment will be valid for the 2007 Javelin National Championships.

## 5.0 Schedule of Events

### 5.1 *Registration:*

Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2007 From 1500hrs to 1900hrs, at the Bay of Islands Yacht Club.

### 5.2 *Measuring:*

Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> April From 1500hrs To 2000hrs, at the Bay of Islands Yacht Club.

### 5.3 *Briefing:*

Friday 6<sup>th</sup> April 2007, 0900hrs, at the Bay of Islands Yacht Club.

### 5.4 *Racing Schedule:*

The scheduled time of the warning signal for Race 1 is 0955 hours on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> April 2007. A total of 9 races are scheduled.

No race shall start after 1500 hours on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> April 2007.

## 6.0 Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available from the Bay of Islands Yacht Club from 1500hrs on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2007.

## 7.0 Racing Area

The races will be held on the waters of the Bay of Islands.

## 8.0 Courses to be Sailed

The course(s) will be Windward/Leeward, triangular & Harbour courses in the Bay of Islands.

## 9.0 Scoring

9.1 5 races will be required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.2 No score will be excluded until 5 races have been completed and a boat's two worst scores will be excluded when 8 or 9 races have been completed.

## **12.0 Prizes**

The following prizes will be awarded:

Ray Eady Trophy: First placed Javelin in the Nationals regatta.

John Long Memorial Trophy: Second placed Javelin in the Nationals regatta.

DFL Trophy: Awarded to last placed Javelin in the Nationals regatta which completes all races.

Junior Trophy: Awarded to highest placed crew with a combined age of 42 years or less on Friday 6th April 2007.

Masters Trophy: Awarded to the highest placed crew with one (1) member aged 45 or over on Friday 6th April 2007.

Crews Race Trophy: First placed Javelin in the Crews Race.

## **13.0 Team Support Boats**

13.1 Team support boats will be allowed, however their activities may be restricted.

13.2 Support boats must be registered with the Organising Authority at registration (clause 5.1 above).
