NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Class rules of the Javelin class will apply.
- 1.3 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing may be offered prior to any formal hearing.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Javelin class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Javelin Nationals, Muritai Yacht Club, PO Box 41005, EASTBOURNE, Wellington by 20th January 2012.
- 3.3 Late entries may be accepted with payment of the late entry fee.
- 3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by each entrant's and crew member's national authority.
- 3.5 Each entrant shall be a financial member of the New Zealand Javelin class owners association.

5.6 On 07 February no warning signal will be made after 14:00 hours.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate. In addition the following measurements may be taken: Hull weight, mast & sails measurements.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 16:00 on 03 February at the Muritai Yacht Club.

8 VENUE

8.1 Attachment 1 shows the location of the regatta venue and racing area.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows: Windward Leeward courses.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 For the Javelin class rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 SCORING

11.1 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 11.2**
- (a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When from 6 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (c) When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12 LAUNCHING

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from the Muritai Yacht Club.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

First placed Javelin: Ray Eady Cup

Second placed Javelin: John Long Memorial Trophy

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

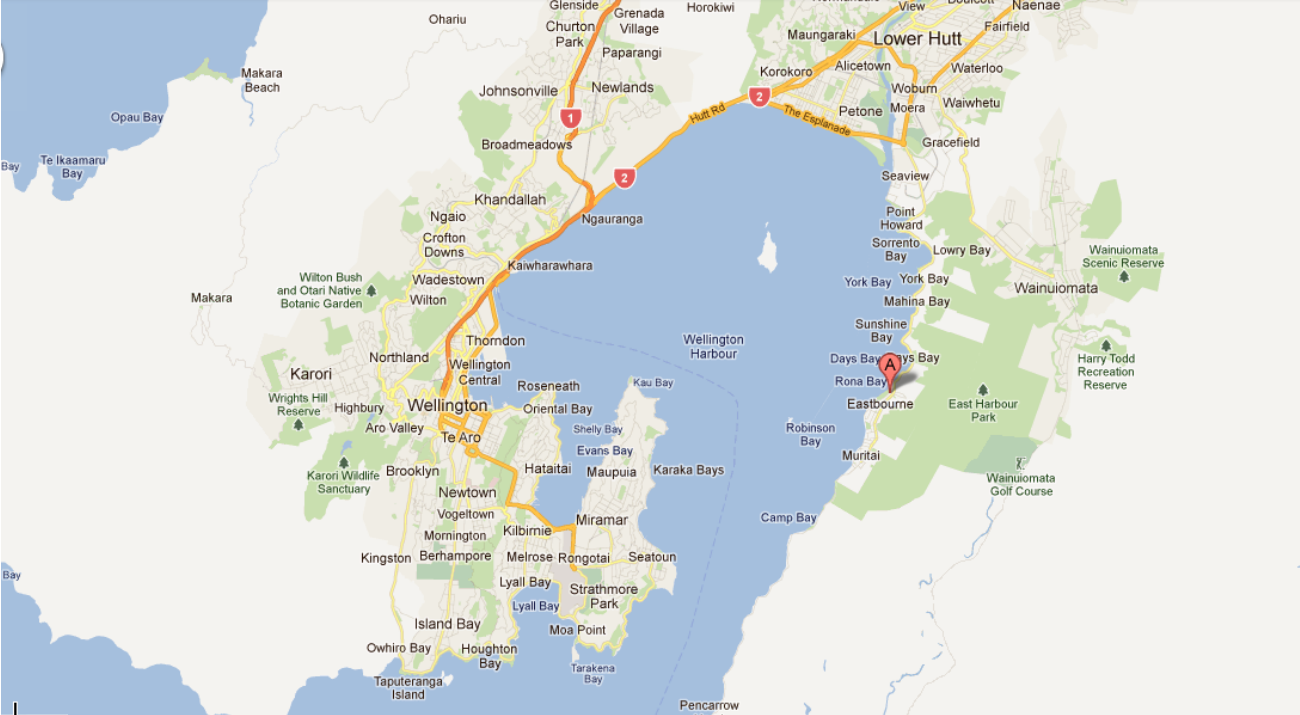
50 Years of Javelin Sailing:
