NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia.
- 1.3 The rules of the Javelin Class Association.
- 1.4 Under rule 87, rule 5 of the Javelin Class Restrictions will apply.

2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display bow numbers and advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all Javelin Class boats and competitors who are members of the Western Australian Javelin Association or an affiliated Australian or New Zealand Javelin Association at the time of registration.
- 3.2 All competitors are required to be members of YA or YNZ and must provide proof of this membership, at registration. All competitors need to have a silver card and be a member of a yacht club.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached Entry Form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Dale Oakley by Friday 18th December 2009.
- 3.4 For all interstate and Esperance competitors the Javelin Association of Western Australia has agreed that the association will subsidize members travelling to Perth for the 09/10 National Javelin Championships.
The agreed subsidy will be in the form of waiving the \$120 entry fee however, in order to qualify for the waiver, the Entry Form must be submitted by the designated closing date of Friday 18 December 2009.
- 3.5 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organising authority until the start of the Invitation Race. A late entry fee will apply.

7. MEASUREMENTS

The following measurements will be taken:

 Weigh all hulls

 Measure all sails, spars and foils

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be published on the Javelin website, www.javelins.org, by Friday 18th December 2009. Copies will be available at registration.

9. VENUE

9.1 Attachment A shows the location of the Perth Dinghy Sailing Club.

9.2 Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

11. THE COURSES

Courses will be Windward-Leeward as described in the sailing instructions.

12. SCORING

- 12.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.2 (a) When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from six to seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When eight or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
- 12.3 A boat's handicap for the handicap series will be determined by an administrator appointed by the WA Javelin Sailing Association and will be adjusted as deemed fit by that administrator.

13. PROTEST MEDIATION

Protests arising from participation in this regatta shall be subject to mediation as detailed in the sailing instructions.

14. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for national championship and handicap results. Handicap prizes will be presented following each day of racing, with championship prizes being presented on Monday 4th January 2010 at the presentation dinner.

16. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESSES

Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any text, motion pictures, video and still pictures, as well as live, taped or filmed television of, or relating to, the Championship.

17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, "Decision to Race". The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000 per event or equivalent. By signing the Entry Form, entrants are deemed to have made a declaration that they have such cover.

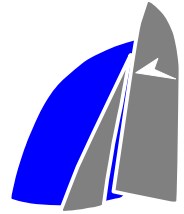

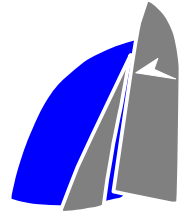
